INSTALLATION  TILE	The method of installation should conform to BS5325. For details of subfloor preparation and a full guide to installation visit: www.heckmondwike-fb.co.uk. Before laying Hobnail, tiles should be allowed to condition for 24 hours at the expected temperature and humidity levels. Hobnail tiles should be laid rotationally, alternating the direction of the tiles through 90°.
ADHESIVE GUIDE	Sheet carpet should be fully adhered with F Ball's F3 or Bostik Laybond Carpet Adhesive. Sheet carpets can be laid into F40 as a release system. For tiles, use Tackifier F41 or Bostik Laybond Carpet tile Tackifier.
MAINTENANCE	To achieve maximum life expectancy, it is essential to initiate a maintenance schedule from the date of installation. A full guide to cleaning & maintenance is available at: www.heckmondwike-fb.co.uk
